HVAC RACK:

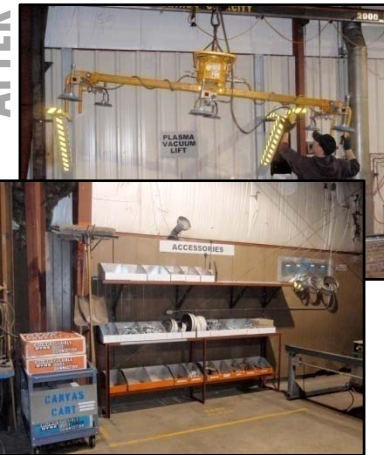
TEAM: Dale T. (Team Lead), Duane H., Brent T., Wayne F.
